

**SCHEDULE
FOR SCOTLAND TRIP
AS OF AUG 4, 1987**

Aug 10, Monday —

12:00 — Load up at 54 Elm Street

12:15 — Leave 54 Elm St for Boston

2:15 — Arrive at LaBell's Airport Park. (Bear left after going through tunnel in Boston.)

2:30 — Arrive at Logan Airport, Northwest Terminal.

3:30 — Airplane leaves. Flight #35 for JFK, New York. arr 4:35. Lv JFK at 7:40 for Prestwick, Scotland, via Northwest Airlines Flight # 38.

Aug 11, Tuesday. — Arrive Preswick 6:50 a.m. Pick up vans, Visit Culzean Castle, Eisenhower's during WWII. It's near Ayr. Afternoon go to Fringe Festival Club (food, booze and possibly showers available) John Nuttall's

6:00 p.m. - Collected from Fringe Club. Hosts (with possible exceptions to be decided will collect in cars and take to home. See separate pages.

Meal - See Note No. 1

Evening - Meet in a pub. To be determined.

Aug 12, Wednesday - A Lothians man (John Nuttall?) will accompany as far as Dundee. (Meet at some central point in Edinburgh - hosts will help - to get in mini-busses.

Morning dance at Culross (Fife). Just turn up and dance. A chance to see the Old Town and possibly the "Palace".

Lunch - at Falkland. Dance. Just turn up and dance. Chance to see the Palace.

4:00 p.m. - Dance at St Andrews John Nuttall has arranged with police.

Drive - via Dundee, Forfar, Brechin, Fettercairn, Cairn a'Mount to Banchory.

6:00 - 7:00 p.m. - Meet Banchory men in the Banchory Hotel (or to be announced (evening meal? chippy?)

Stay at homes of Banchory Morris men: Neil Bayfield - bagman, "Pathhead",

Aug 13, Thursday (Banchory men will not be available during the working day.) Dance at Ballater. Just turn up and dance. Braemaar. Just turn up and dance. Look at Balmoral (not if Queen in residence) ((no dancing, and eg Craigivar. Evening Tour with Banchory Men.

Aug 15, Saturday—Hosts will get visitor to the first spot somehow.

10:00 a.m. - Dance at a city centre shop (Waverley Market / Foot of Mound?)

12:00 noon - Lunch at Traquir Arms (to be arranged by Fingers)

2:00 p.m. onwards - dance at Traquir.

Return to Edinburgh. Chance to do a bit of festival bashing or recovering prior to Tattoo.

10:00 p.m. Tattoo. It can be chilly - John Nuttall has the Westerly's tickets.

Aug 16, Sunday—Lunch at Tibby Shiels (This is an isolated pub in the Ettrick Forest, beyond Traquir.

PM - Dance again at Traquir. Return to Edinburgh via the Moorfoot Hills.

Aug 17, Monday—Leave Lothians. To Carlisle — (See separate note.) and visit Syn-ton House near Ashkirk, in the border country.

5:00 pm.— Meet at Squire's House. South of The Cliff Pub on Right side of road. Called "Alstonby Villa". Supper. (see map)

8:00 — Mediaeval event in courtyard of Carlisle Castle. We will do our Cottswold Morris.

00:00— Visit with the Carlisle Sword and Morris. Contact is

Aug 18, Tuesday — Sight seeing in the Lake District. We might have a Carlisle morris man guide our tour. Then drive north to Scotland. John Nuttall has booked us for three nights at the King's House hotel and the adjacent bunkhouse (On Rannoch Moor, near the top of Glen Coe.) There is one spare place also booked - up for grabs. (Kate Walker?). The Coordinates on the national grid are NN-259-546.

Aug 22, Saturday—Travel to town centre by public transport.

Dance at Foot of Mound, Wavery Market, Grassmarket. Lunch at the Fringe Club

Afternoon - Free for sightseeing. the major tourist attractions (the Castle, Scott Monument, Holyrood, etc., are all within easy walking distance.) Evening - Ceilidh and a Buffet supper at Juniper Green (Kate is supervising the food).

Aug 23, Sunday—Lunchtime at Castle Inn, Dirlerton. The actual castle is just over the road, and can be visited easily. A snack lunch is being arranged. PM - Evening barbeque at Yellowcraigs beach (Cath is organising food. Home brew (Tantallon Castle, spectacularly sited on cliffs above the Forth estuary, is a few miles away.

Aug 24, Monday —Say good byes. Depart early. And go to airport. Leave Prestwick 10:55 am. Arrive at Boston at 12:30 pm. on Flight #35, Northwest Airlines.

NOTE 1. — Hosts will provide certain meals in their own homes as far as possible, but people's home and work circumstances differ. Food will always be available in the vicinity.

NOTE 2. — There is a problem to be resolved about the mini-buses (vans). You will probably be allowed only two or three drivers per bus. The location of the buses overnight needs to be considered - see separate pages on accomodations. In general, it is a bad idea to take the min-buses into town — it is offer better to take public transport. We'll sort this out nearer the time. You minibus drivers should think about driving on the left of the road before arrival — especially about roundabouts (rotaries).

NOTE 3. — The weather in Scotland is variable, both by the day and by the hour. You are likely to have both good and bad weather during your stay. Be prepared for rain. Average temperatures are rather cooler than you are used to, and even on hot days there tends to be a breeze. The hours of daylight are longer, with a long twilight, but the last hour of daylight will be cool.
